They should never go it alone. Let's make sure they know that we're standing by, ready to lend support and encouragement. It's our obligation. But much more than that, it's our privilege.


I therefore PROCLAIM the month of MAY 2010 to be **YOUTH ORDERS MONTH**

and I direct that this Proclamation be read by the master at the May stated meeting and included in the lodge Trestleboard.





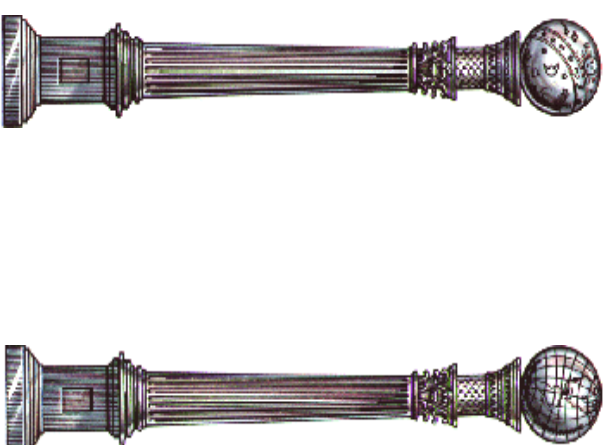
